

Kudzu Kollege

This course takes place several times a year. It usually held at Creekside Nursery, on Drayton Road in Spartanburg, South Carolina.

It is a one day class with complete coverage of kudzu history, kudzu problems, all of our non-chemical treatments, before and after photographs of demonstration sites, and so on. The classroom education is supplemented by outdoor activities, which includes a walk-through of our experimental plots, and hands-on training and experience killing kudzu. Yep: Participants do "[surgical removal](#)" and cut off the heads of kudzu plants! So wear comfortable clothes, long pants, sturdy regular shoes (no flip-flops or sandals!), and long sleeve cover-up. Gloves are useful, but we provide tools. The course finishes with a question and answer session, followed by graduation.
